Remembering how each of us come to this point on the path from our own experiences, will help us to remain connected to the path ahead. Allowing us to see the new things bursting out for us together. The words of new possibilities touch on the very heart of Christian change for me. The way God guides people to come together for a time to work toward the transformation of the world, inspires me to be willing to accept a time of change and all the stress that comes along with it.

The last verse of this scripture points to the changes to come and to trust in God as the path unfolds ahead. "Be alert, be present. I'm about to do something brand-new. It's bursting out! Don't you see it? There it is! I'm making a road through the desert, rivers in the badlands." Our time together is not through a desert or badlands, but we are to trust in the path we walk for the transformation of our world, knowing something new is coming. Shalom, Pastor Joel
